As a result of the discussion during the Pre-Bid Conference conducted on July 01, 2020, the herein information(s)/document(s) shall be added and will form part an integral part of the Bid Documents for the Provision of Security Services, to wit:

1. Pre-Bid Conference	Due to conduct of COA-TESDA Joint Engagement Conference 2020, a videoconferencing with all TESDA Employees and COA, the Pre-Bid Conference is moved from 1:30 PM to 10:00 AM, same day, same venue.
2. Memorandum issued (Pre-Bid Conference)	Time indicated in the Memorandum issued is adjusted to 10:00 AM, due to the conduct of COA-TESDA Joint Engagement Conference, same venue, same day.
3. Bid Security	The Bid Security shall be any of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 2% of the ABC for Cash, MC, CC, Bank Guarantee or Irrevocable Letter of Credit ➤ 5% of the ABC for Surety Bond (Surety or Insurance Company must be duly authorized by the Insurance Commission to issue such bond) ➤ Bid Securing Declaration
4. Bid Data Sheet	BDS ITB clause 12.1 (a)(iii) item #2, an additional eligibility requirement states that Security Guards must at least be certified on Security Services NC II. In the instance that the Security Guards haven't been certified yet on account of the Pandemic (COVID-19), they can take their assessments while they are rendering their security services or when the releasing body (TESDA) is already allowed to do so.

6. Approved Budget for the Contract	<p>The approved Purchase Request is initially Php 3,456,000.00 (April 1 to December 31, 2020). Reflected in the bid documents is Php 2,304,000.00 with a project duration of six (6) months from July 1 to December 31, 2020 and should be the basis for the computation since upon approval, the number of days consummated shall be deducted from the ABC.</p> <p>Likewise, actual amount to be reflected in the contract should be based on the actual number of days.</p>
